

# MassDOT Advisory: Boston

## Evenings of May 13 through 15: overnight full closures of Sumner Tunnel

**BOSTON** – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) has announced that the Sumner Tunnel in Boston will be closed to all vehicular traffic during the overnight hours of 11 p.m., through 5 a.m., on the evening of Monday, May 13, and well as the evenings of Tuesday, May 14, and Wednesday, May 15. During these overnight hours, all vehicular traffic seeking to access the Sumner Tunnel will be detoured to the Ted Williams Tunnel.

These closures are necessary to allow crews to safely and effectively install sign structures. Signage and messaging will be in place to notify drivers of these operations. MassDOT encourages the public to be mindful of potential traffic impacts.

Those traveling through the area should reduce speed and use caution. The schedule for this work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
